## Policy on Codes of Conduct, Ethics, and Diversity

VSU MFT students are expected to read and sign willingness to adhere to the following:

- 1. VSU Student Code of Conduct
- 2. Minors on Campus Adult Code of Conduct for Authorized Adults
- 3. AAMFT Code of Ethics
- 4. MFT Diversity Statement

This expectation of adherence to the above is made apparent during the admission process and prior to a to accept a seat in the program. Each student invited to join a new incoming class receives a welcome letter that informs them that students are required to attest to their ability and willingness to follow the <u>VSU Student Code of Conduct the AAMFT Code of Ethics</u> and the <u>MFT Diversity</u> <u>Statement</u>. An excerpt from this Welcome letter reads as follows:

If you have decided to join the VSU MFT Program, we need to know this so that we can reserve your seat. Please compose a short email (just a sentence or two is fine) that reflects your intent to begin the program starting in the Fall of 20XX, and send it to the <u>Clinic Director</u>, <u>Program Director</u>, Graduate Assistant 1 and Graduate Assistant 2. Once we receive your email, a seat is reserved for you.
